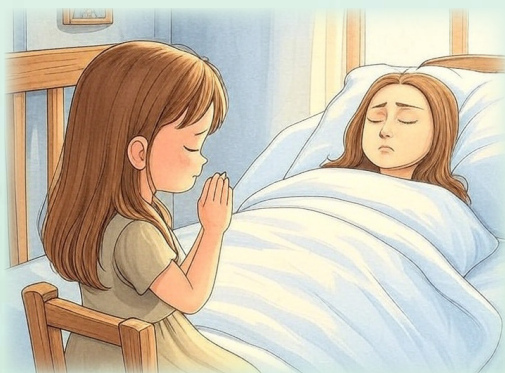
Do you love God? Do you take a moment to thank Him? Rest assured, God loves you unconditionally! I cherish God with the deepest affection in my heart.

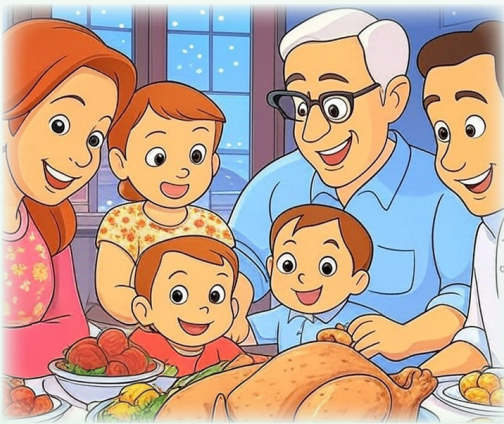
